

Crime	Punishment
<p>For the crime of trafficking in narcotics and psychotropic substances in the following cases:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the offender commits the crime again. If the offender uses a minor or a person with mental illness to commit the crime. If the crime occurs in prisons, police stations, rehabilitation or addiction-treatment centres, places of worship, educational institutions, or sports clubs. If the offender exploits his/her official authority. If the offender provides a minor with narcotic or psychotropic substances for the purpose of consumption. For anyone who establishes or manages an organized criminal group for the purpose of committing narcotics and psychotropic substance crimes. For anyone who forces another person to consume narcotic or psychotropic substances, or administers them into the victim's body without their knowledge, resulting in death. For anyone who plants narcotic substances on another person with the intent to accuse them of possession, or to hide such substances with them without their knowledge of their nature, resulting in a death sentence being issued against the victim and the sentence being executed. 	<p>Death Penalty</p>



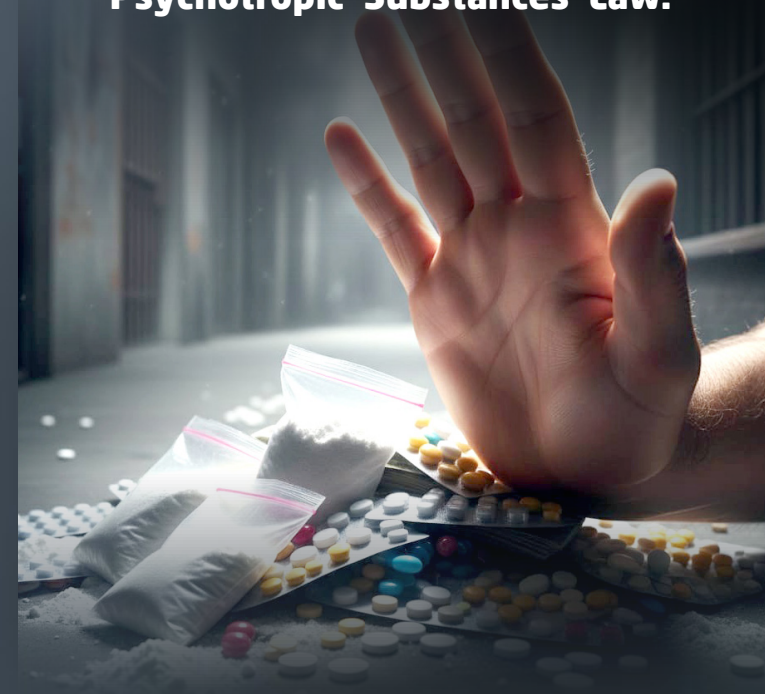

The National Campaign to Raise Awareness of the Narcotics and Psychotropic Substances Law.



Crime	Punishment
<p>For anyone who joins an organized criminal group that commits crimes related to narcotics and psychotropic substances.</p> <p>For anyone who plants narcotic or psychotropic substances on another person with the intent to accuse them of possession, or to hide the substances with them without their knowledge of their nature, which results in:</p> <p>A final judgment of imprisonment against the victim.</p> <p>If the offender is a member of the police force.</p> <p>For anyone who forces another person to consume narcotic or psychotropic substances or administers them into the victim's body without their knowledge:</p> <p>For the purpose of committing a crime against the victim or others.</p> <p>If this results in the victim becoming addicted.</p> <p>If the victim suffers serious harm or a permanent disability.</p>	Life Imprisonment

Crime	Punishment
Importing or smuggling narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances for the purpose of trafficking.	Death Penalty or Life Imprisonment and a Fine Up to 2 Million Kuwaiti Dinars
Producing or manufacturing narcotic or psychotropic substances for the purpose of trafficking.	
Cultivating narcotic plants for the purpose of trafficking	
Possession, purchase, or sale of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances for the purpose of trafficking.	Death Penalty or Life Imprisonment and a Fine Up to 500,000 Kuwaiti Dinars
Promotion of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances.	
Exchanging narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances, or providing any quantity of them in return for monetary compensation for the purpose of consumption.	
For personal use or consumption of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances.	Imprisonment Not Exceeding 5 Years and a Fine Up to 5000 Kuwaiti Dinars
For personal use or consumption of narcotic drugs or psychotropic substances inside prisons, police stations, rehabilitation centres, addiction-treatment facilities, places of worship, educational institutions, or sports clubs	Imprisonment Not Exceeding 10 Years and a Fine Up to 10,000 Kuwaiti Dinars
For anyone who associates with individuals who use narcotics or psychotropic substances, even if they do not personally consume them, provided they are aware of such drug use.	Imprisonment Up to 3 Years and a Fine Up to 5000 Kuwaiti Dinars or Either Penalty

Crime	Punishment
For anyone who plants narcotic or psychotropic substances on another person for the purpose of accusing them of possession or hiding the substances with them without their knowledge of their nature.	Imprisonment from 5 to 10 Years and a Fine from 5000 to 10,000 Kuwaiti Dinar
For anyone who forces another person to consume narcotic or psychotropic substances or administers them into their body without their knowledge.	Imprisonment Not Exceeding 15 Years and a Fine Not Exceeding 20,000 Kuwaiti Dinars
For anyone who issues a medical prescription containing narcotic or psychotropic substances, or allows their dispensing by any means for the purpose of consumption.	Imprisonment Up to 3 Years and a Fine from 5000 to 10,000 Kuwaiti Dinars or Either Penalty
For anyone who manufactures, promotes, sells, or possesses for the purpose of trafficking any goods, printed materials, or logos containing images, drawings, writings, or ideas that encourage or incite the commission of narcotic or psychotropic substance crimes.	Fine from 3000 to 20,000 Kuwaiti Dinars
For anyone who wears or uses goods, printed materials, or logos containing images, drawings, writings, or ideas that encourage or incite the commission of narcotic crimes.	Fine Up to 500 Kuwaiti Dinars
For anyone who encourages, entices, or incites another person to possess, purchase, smuggle, or produce narcotic or psychotropic substances for personal use or consumption.	Imprisonment Not Exceeding 3 Years and a Fine Not Exceeding 5000 Kuwaiti Dinars or Either Penalty
The court may increase the legally prescribed penalty up to double the maximum limit if the offender commits a violent crime, one involving threats, or one that causes harm to others or their property while under the influence of narcotic or psychotropic substances.
